OFFICE REMINDERS

Attendance - all students must arrive at school by **8:15 am** or else they are late. If a student is late, they must come to the office to retrieve a tardy slip. If your child is ill, please call the office ahead of time so the school can mark them appropriately.

Parent Volunteers & Visiting Campus - We require all parent volunteers/visitors to give 24 hour notification if they plan on coming to campus. All visitors must sign in to the office before walking onto campus and then sign out.

There are no visitors allowed on campus before 8:05 unless it's pre-arranged by a staff member.

End of School - If your student is not picked up by 2:15 pm, they will be walked down to the office. Notify the office and teacher if you will be late picking up your child.

NURSE'S NOOK

Immunization update: the CDPH has reminded us that only students who have their full set of immunizations are eligible to attend school. Nurse Claudette (<u>ccantiller@millbraesd.org</u>) and Mrs. Lampros (<u>mlampros@millbraesd.org</u>) are collecting all missing records and entering them into Synergy. The state has provided a 10-School-Day grace to allow time to get the immunizations. Most pharmacies in Millbrae stock them. If you have already provided a complete record of your child's immunizations, a new record isn't necessary.

If your student needs to take medications at school, we are required to have a newly signed Parent/Physician Authorization to administer medication at the start of every school year. All medications need to be in properly labeled, original containers along with the authorized health care provider's instructions. For prescription medication, the container shall bear the name and telephone number of the pharmacy, the student's identification, and the name and telephone number of the authorized health care provider. (Ed Code 5 CCR 6)
