The Mills High School students helped build boats to float in and showed how different matter will either float or sink depending on the liquid.

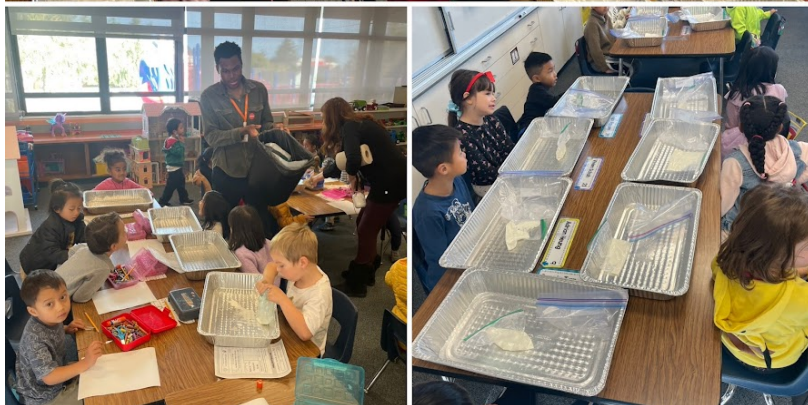


CAM-ED SCIENCE DEMONSTRATION
